Why introduce the International Peace Tree Program to the world of art and handcrafts?

The 5 reconnection practices of the International Peace Trees Program greatly help artists and artisans to connect with their inner strengths and riches and express them on a new level of excellence, innovation, and fame.

The program also gives them the opportunity to support children, youth, and all citizens, to create inspirational artwork around peace, kindness, and the SDGs.

The practices of excellence included in the International Program allow artists to:

1. Be helped in the management of stress and emotions in order to excel in their art.
2. Live with inner harmony, which is conducive to creativity.
3. Participate in children's creative works in schools around the theme of peace, the SDGs, and Peace Trees.
4. Consciously create highly inspiring artworks for today's humanity in support of children, their future, and the future of the planet.
5. Participate in creating innovative exhibitions, in synergy with cities around the world on the theme of peace and SDGs.
6. Contribute actively to the well-being of all populations and to the support of the children by creating artwork that shares the heart message of "I wish you peace." After the collective exhibition, these artistic works can be displayed in public and private places and will serve as "well-doing reminders" to passersby.
7. Cooperate with the most disadvantaged groups of people who are in difficulty or are feeling excluded. For example, those who are hospitalized, refugees, imprisoned, homeless, or otherwise isolated, giving them the opportunity to create and contribute artistically through the expression of their talents around the themes of peace and the SDGs.

9. To provide women in developing countries with new opportunities through the label "Artisans for Peace," enabling them to create fulfilling opportunities and meaningful financial incomes to live decently and to serenely sustain their families.
10. For art teachers, art therapists, and workshop managers, these tools help in everyday life to support creative people from the heart to feel their talents and fully reveal their most beautiful potential and all the inner riches present within them.
